A NOTE ON THE AUSTRALIAN WHISKY COLLECTION

Our curated selection of 100+ bottles of Australian whisky celebrates both the pioneers who laid the groundwork, and the emerging distillers who are pushing the boundaries of this exciting industry.

Australian whiskies are legitimately becoming some of the most collectable and drinkable drams in the world, but local whiskies are still relatively new.

In 1822, Thomas Haigh Midwood established Australia's first legal distillery in Tasmania, known as Sorell Distillery. By the late 1830s, Tasmania had over a dozen distilleries, but this early progress was halted by Governor John Franklin's prohibition. It wasn't until the early 1990s, with the opening of Lark Distillery and some early production in South Australia, that Australia's boutique and craft whisky industry regained momentum.

While our industry is still in its infancy compared to the centuries-old traditions of Scotland and Ireland, we are rapidly gaining recognition on the world stage. At Bar Tilda, we showcase these whiskies, which are not only a taste of our agriculture, climate and history but also a glimpse into the future.
